

Become a Healthy FE Adviser



LSIS want to engage a range of consultants to assist in the delivery of the Healthy FE Programme. This would include providing training and consultancy to FE and skills providers who wish to become recognised Healthy FE providers and/or further develop the promotion of health and wellbeing to staff and learners within their organisations.

LSIS are keen to ensure that this service is available to all providers in the sector, including Work-Based Learning providers, Adult and Community Learning providers, Offender Learning and Specialist Colleges.

Applications for Healthy FE Advisers can be made by:

- Individuals who have expertise in promoting Healthy FE
- Individuals who are self-employed as freelance consultants
- Individuals who are currently employed within FE and skills organisations who will undertake this work during work-time and LSIS will reimburse their organisations for their time.

Job role

1. To develop training materials and packages on a range of topics:
 - Getting started as a Healthy FE provider and making use of the existing Healthy FE tools and resources
 - Whole organisational approaches to Healthy FE including working with Governors and Senior Managers
 - Supporting learners to lead Healthy FE development work
 - Working in partnership with key stakeholder organisations eg Primary Care Trusts, employers
 - Topic based approaches eg. Sexual Health, Mental Health, Working with more and different learners
2. To deliver training and consultancy to FE colleges, Work-based Learning, Adult and Community Learning, Sixth Form Colleges, Independent Specialist Colleges or Offender Learning providers

1. Experience of leading Healthy FE work within your organisation, or other organisations, to develop and promote health and wellbeing to the FE and skills sector, either at a strategic or operational level.
2. Knowledge and expertise on using the Healthy FE tools or other ways of promoting health and wellbeing in FE and skills sector settings

3. Expertise and experience in developing training materials and resources for different audiences.
4. Experience of delivering training or as acting as a consultant to another organisation in order to support their development.

The consultancy fee

- £475 per day for delivery of training and consultancy or development time to write and produce training packages and materials.
- Travel and subsistence will be paid in addition to the daily rate.
