## What is it?

The iRoute is a series of interactive activities on the Move On website to support the promotion of English and maths training opportunities.

## How to use it

You can use the iRoute as part of an introduction to literacy, language and numeracy (LLN) across the organisation, and to support:

- induction, reviews, appraisals and meetings to ensure the LLN opportunities are part of ongoing procedures
- the achievement of liP by contributing to the learning culture of an organisation
- delivery of professional standards for teachers, tutors and trainers in the lifelong learning sector
- general training around raising awareness of LLN barriers to learning and increasing participation
- a positive approach to marketing LLN learning opportunities.

Make sure you take advantage of the iRoute print-out facility so that you have a record of the quizzes, activities and action plans to support your work in the positive promotion of English and maths.

## More about the content

The Move On iRoute helps you develop your own knowledge about English and maths training and qualifications to help people achieve.

It provides awareness-raising information on literacy, language and numeracy and details about the adult English and maths qualifications – what they are like and how they fit with other qualifications and courses.

It also has *Mind your language* and *Action planning* sections that consider such questions as:

- How do you get people interested in LLN?
- How do you break down barriers?
- What support is available to you and your organisation?
- What are your next steps?
- How will you make it happen?
